NOTICE OF REVISION AND ADDENDUM IN CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

CLARIFICATIONS

All bidders are hereby notified of the following clarifications to the contract requirements:

1. This contract does NOT have a supplier exception; the Bidder may count payments to MBE or WBE regular Dealers or Manufacturers for no more than 50% of each MBE or WBE goal.
2. If the Bidder exceeds the supplier exception amount allowable as stated in the bid documents, the bid will be viewed as non-responsive!
3. Example:
 - Contract Value: \$1,000,000
 - Goals: 20% MBE and 10% WBE
 - The Utilization Plan must show:
 - (a) \$200,000 allocated to MBE firm(s)
 - (b) \$100,000 allocated to WBE firm(s)
 - How much of this can be allocated to suppliers?
 - (a) No Supplier Exception: Only 50% for each goal may be used for materials and supplies.
 - (b) MBE Supplier Allocation: Up to \$100,000 (50% of \$200,000)
 - (c) WBE Supplier Allocation: Up to \$50,000 (50% of \$100,000)
