A copy of the legislation was provided to the Ethics Commissioners. The Office of the Independent Inspector General has broad powers to detect, deter and prevent corruption, fraud, waste, mismanagement, unlawful political discrimination or misconduct in the operation of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago.
